A Tool for Collaborative work

- Services for each project:
 - hosts web pages
 - hosts bug tracker
 - hosts mailing-lists
 - hosts CVS or SVN server

Public and Private projects

- All the data stored in a public project is:
 - read-only for everyone
 - read-write for the members of the project
- The data (except the web pages) stored in a private project is:
 - read-write for the members of the project
 - not accessible to anyone else
- The access to the server is protected by:
 - ssl authentication for the web server and
 - ssh private/public key authentication for the cvs/svn repositories.



How can you use it ?

- You need to:
 - create an account
 - upload your ssh key
 - create a project or ask a project admin to add you to an existing project
- Before reporting a problem or asking a question to the server administrators, please:
