## Call for bilateral projects between DIT and Inria Sophia Antipolis-Méditerranée

In the framework of the bilateral agreement between the University of Athens and Inria Sophia Antipolis-Méditerranée (France), coordinated by the Department of Informatics and Telecommunications (DIT), we issue a **Call for Bilateral Projects between DIT and Inria Sophia Antipolis-Méditerranée.** 

The aim is to foster research collaboration and the preparation of joint participation in proposals of European research projects. Projects must include at least one team from DIT and one from Inria Sophia Antipolis. The evaluation criteria include scientific excellence, maturity of the proposal, and prior contact between the two teams.

Projects have a duration of one year. The total budget on the Greek side is up to €15,000, and aims to support up to 4 teams from DIT. The French teams will be funded by Inria, the total budget being up to €15,000. Eligible costs include: visits between the teams, longer visits or short internships for students, effort for research collaboration and the preparation of research proposals.

Each proposal must include, in a single file (preferably PDF): the project's objective, the teams and the team members involved, a scientific description (up to 2 pages), a time-plan, and the budget requested (see the accompanying Proposal Form). Results will be announced by the end of July 2013 and collaborations can begin in September 2013.

The evaluation of proposals will be carried out by a joint committee from DIT and Inria. The committee's members from DIT are: I. Emiris, M. Koubarakis, and I. Stavrakakis, and from Inria: C. Barakat, J-C. Bermond, and R. Deriche.
