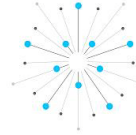

Call for Demonstrations

Building up on the success of the demonstration sessions held in Stockholm in 2009 and Ghent in 2010, the Demonstration Program for 2011 is intended to showcase innovative implementation approaches, technologies and tools related to the Future Converged Internet of Content (IoC), Services (IoS) and Things (IoT).

Submissions

All submissions to the Demonstrations Session should include a title, a short description of the system, a summary of its novel characteristics and the functions and features that will be demonstrated. Authors must include a link to a short video of the demonstration (screen cam with voice-over of no more than 6 minutes) in their application. In the interest of interoperability, authors are encouraged to upload their video files to sites such as youtube.com or vimeo.com, using password protection if necessary, rather than host videos on their own systems.

Accepted papers will be published in the ServiceWave conference proceedings. Submissions must be in English, should not exceed 2 pages, and must be in LNCS Format (see <http://www.springer.de/comp/lncs/authors.html>). Applications must be submitted using EasyChair at <http://www.easychair.org/conferences/?conf=sw2011> under the demonstrations track. Submissions that exceeds the guidelines for length or that do not include a link to a video will be rejected. Only features of the system that are clearly showcased in the video will be taken into account in the review. Authors are strongly encouraged to put as much effort into explaining the context of their research and the relevance of the problem addressed (i.e. "WHY we did it") as they do introducing the features of the demonstrated system (i.e. "WHAT we built and HOW").

All submissions will be reviewed by at least two members of the ServiceWave 2011 demonstrations program committee. Submissions will be evaluated on the basis of originality, importance of contribution, soundness, quality of presentation and credibility of the video. At least one author of the paper is expected to present the results at the ServiceWave 2011 conference
