

## List of events of interest to FIRE (as of 17<sup>th</sup> September 2010)

---

The table included in this note lists all events that are of potential interest to FIRE research and facility projects. The main objectives of FIRE participation to such events are to promote and give visibility to FIRE facilities and FIRE research projects, and to increase the usage of FIRE facilities by research projects and initiatives, at European and at international level. The most important events in relation with FIRE are highlighted in **bold brown**. The other ones will be prioritized with the FIRE projects.

The FIRESTATION project will continuously monitor upcoming announcements for other events of potential interest to FIRE as part of WP4 “External Relations”, in relation with the FIRE Project Office (WP2) and the FIRE Architecture Board (WP3) where information will be exchanged with FIRE facilities. In particular, it is anticipated that presentations of FIRE facilities could be made at “Information Days” organized by the various units of DG InfSo to prepare proposals for a given call, so that participants in the proposals are aware of the FIRE facilities available; and that such presentations could also be given at “Concertation meetings” where projects from a specific objective are gathering to exchange information. The objective would be to provide starting projects with the opportunity to explore the possibility to use FIRE facilities for the test experiments most of them are planning for the last stage of their projects. The dates of such meetings are not known very much in advance and only a few of them have been included so far in the table below.
