SAFA Annual Workshop on Formal Techniques (SAFA'2010)

CALL FOR PAPERS

The Sophia-Antipolis Formal Analysis (SAFA) group has been created in 2007 for researchers and engineers involved in the use of formal techniques in Sophia-Antipolis (France) and its region (PACA). Members of both public and private institutions are welcome in the group. The first aim of this group is for attendees to exchange valuable information on formal description and analysis techniques in domains electrical, software engineering, automotive and model-driven engineering. Another goal is to root synergies between local academic and private researchers, first to increase the visibility of Sophia-Antipolis in formal methods, and second to settle new local, national or international research projects.

The SAFA annual workshop is to happen on the 6th and 7th of October, 2010. Presenters must submit an extended abstract that will be evaluated throughout a selection process. Contributions can be either scientific papers or demonstration papers, covering the scopes listed below. Selected papers will be offered a 30minute presentation slot. All papers will be published along with the SAME'2010 proceedings (USB key). These proceedings shall be considered as informal i.e. non-original work might be submitted, even if we preferably target unpublished work.
